



2008 CANADA RACE SERIES CONTINGENCY PROGRAM

Any racer using PIRELLI tires will be eligible to compete for Pirelli Contingency rewards:

- **Please refer to the online Pirelli Road Racing Contingency Program: www.us.pirelli.com/contingency for the classes, finishes and prize amounts.**
- **A minimum of 8 riders for each class must start the race to be eligible.**

INSTRUCTIONS:

- STEP 1: Complete reverse side of form prior to race day sign-up. **Incomplete or non-verified forms will not be paid contingency rewards.**
- STEP 2: Turn completed forms into sign-up **BEFORE** racing.
- STEP 3: Racers **must** go through post tech after each race to have tech form verified. Race club/organization officials must mail only the qualified contingency winners to Pirelli. Pirelli requires the **completed, verified tech forms and the race results.**
- STEP 4: **Race results and tech forms not** turned in by the race organization within **60** days of the event **will be forfeited.** Racers are responsible for making sure the race organization sends contingency results and tech forms to Pirelli. Racers are responsible for submitting any address changes to the race club/organization.
- STEP 5: Log on to us.pirelli.com/contingency, register on the contingency website, and claim your results. Payout Cards from Pirelli will be available and mailed out after the official race results and release forms are received and match your results.
(Cards are valid for 6 months)
- STEP 6: A signed W-9 form must be sent by Fax or e-mail to contingency@pirelli.com one time for individuals and once a year for businesses. The form is available on our website.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. List PIRELLI MOTORCYCLE TIRES as a sponsor.
2. PIRELLI stickers must be displayed in the following places on your motorcycle:
 - A. A 6 inch vertical sticker on both sides of the front fender or curved Pirelli 6" sticker;
 - B. Both sides of the main fairing, Minimum size 8.25" sticker.
 - C. A 8.25-inch sticker on both sides of the tail section or swing arm
3. A Pirelli patch must be worn on leathers in the upper chest area or on the front of the shoulders.
4. PIRELLI tires **must** be on both front and rear of motorcycle.
5. Sign and fill out the release form (on opposite side) and **ensure** that a **Race official verifies the form.**
6. Use one form per motorcycle per race day.
